

Via Satellite Announces Matthew Desch Executive of the Year 2011

Matthew Desch, Chief Executive Officer, [Iridium Communications](#) [1], has been named *Via Satellite's* Satellite Executive of the Year for 2011. Iridium boasted a strong performance in 2011 that exceeded estimates on nearly every metric. Financially speaking, the MSS operator grew in areas where it was not expected to grow, driven by its service, its technological innovation and its ability to be a catalyst to its ecosystem of development partners in an increasingly competitive sector and in new sectors, as well.

The company performed solidly from a financial perspective in 2011. In the nine months to the end of September, the operator generated close to \$290 million in revenues, an increase of just under \$30 million compared to the same stage last year. Its net income for the nine months ended September 30, 2011 was also up reaching more than \$31 million, more than double when compared to the same period last year. In areas such as equipment revenue, it significantly outperformed expectations.

But, there is more to the Iridium story than just the numbers. There were also many operational highlights for Iridium in 2011. In July, Iridium announced that Desch was appointed to serve on the U.S. National Security Telecommunications Advisory Committee (NSTAC). Desch now advises and provides recommendations to U.S. President Barack Obama and other government leaders on the security of the nation's telecommunications systems.

In September 2011, Iridium saved up a month's worth of new mobile satellite products and services announcements and packaged them into Iridium ForceSM – an initiative that involved the opening of its core Iridium technology licensing, the launch of a new handset (the Iridium Extreme™) and the expansion of capabilities under its existing portfolio. The Iridium Force strategy includes allowing connectivity to Wi-Fi enabled devices such as smartphones, tablets and laptops through the new Iridium AxxessPoint™ suite of products as well as for applications beyond the reach of terrestrial networks.

“There's no denying that Matt Desch has charted a considerable change of course for Iridium since its days focused on a completely different business model back in the early portion of the previous decade,” said Mark Holmes, associate editor of *Via Satellite*. “Many satellite industry watchers saw the Iridium NEXT Coface financing deal in 2010 as the catalyst that solidified its comeback. Iridium's performance under Desch's leadership in 2011 is a testament to the operator's progress in recent times. We are proud to recognize Matt Desch as the 2011 Satellite Executive of the Year.”
